A Resolution in Opposition to the Expansion of New Seasons Market in Seattle

Sponsored by Ben Lindsey

- Whereas, an out-of-state grocery chain called New Seasons Market is expanding its operations to the Puget Sound Region, including a planned store in Ballard and presents itself as a socially responsible natural foods company, on par with Seattle's community-owned cooperative grocers and local family-operated grocery stores, but in fact, New Seasons Market is majority-owned by private equity investors through Endeavour Capital, a firm with more than \$2 billion under management;^[i] and
- Whereas, one of the investors in the Endeavour Capital funds which own New Seasons Market is the Vancouver-based Murdock Charitable Trust, an organization which has contributed millions of dollars to organizations that actively undermine Northwest values of mutual respect, inclusiveness and tolerance; and
- Whereas, the Murdock Charitable Trust has contributed \$975,000 to the anti-LGBTQ hate group, Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF); and
- Whereas, the Southern Poverty Law Center recently designated the Murdock-funded ADF a hate group due to its role in supporting the criminalization of homosexuality in several countries and because it has "regularly demonized LGBT people, falsely linking them to pedophilia, calling them 'evil' and a threat to children and society..."; and
- Whereas, the ADF provided the model legislation used by numerous states to enact anti-trans "bathroom bills" similar to Initiative 1552, which now threatens to repeal critical protections for transgender Washingtonians; and
- Whereas, the Murdock Charitable Trust has contributed \$350,000 to Focus on the Family, an organization that has promoted gay conversion therapy, argued that homosexuality is preventable and treatable, and spent \$91,000 to defeat civil unions in Washington State; and
- Whereas, the Murdock Charitable Trust has contributed more than \$300,000 to each of two private Christian colleges in Oregon that openly discriminate against LGBTQ students; ix and
- Whereas, the Murdock Charitable Trust has contributed to the Portland Fellowship, an organization that tries to turn gay people straight with gay conversion therapy; and
- Whereas, Murdock Charitable Trust, has contributed over \$1.3 million to so-called "crisis pregnancy centers" across the Pacific Northwest, which NARAL Pro-Choice America says pose as health clinics while providing women with false medical information to dissuade them from having abortions; and
- Whereas, the Murdock Charitable Trust contributed \$240,000 to the Freedom Foundation in 2015, an organization whose staff have explicitly stated that their work is intended to undermine Democratic candidates by defunding public sector unions; xiii and
- Whereas, staff of the Murdock -funded Freedom Foundation have publicly opposed the Supreme Court ruling that legalized same-sex marriage arguing that it is a "threat to personal freedom"; xiv and

- Whereas, the Murdock-funded hate group Alliance Defending Freedom has provided fellowship funding to employees and staff of the Murdock-funded Freedom Foundation;^{xv} and
- Whereas, the expansion of New Seasons Market into our community would help to generate profits for the Murdock Charitable Trust, which could use those profits to further support anti-LGBTQ, anti-women and anti-worker organizations; and
- Whereas, Endeavour Capital is also an investor in Metropolitan Market, a locally-managed grocery chain whose workers benefit from the protections and benefits offered by a collective bargaining agreement; and
- Whereas Endeavour Capital has apparently opted to expand New Seasons Market into Seattle, rather than invest in the growth of Metropolitan Market, a well-liked and locally-managed grocery chain; and
- Whereas, our community has a wide variety of grocery shopping options at stores where hard-won collective bargaining agreements provide workers with decent wages, affordable quality health care, retirement security and a voice on the job; therefore be it
- Resolved, that the 36th District Democrats opposes the entry of New Seasons Market into our Puget Sound communities while one of the company's investors continues to fund extremist anti-LGBTQ, anti-women and anti-worker groups; and be it further
- Resolved that the 36th District Democrats pledges to support local grocery workers' in their effort to defend the economic gains and workplace rights that have been won through the collective bargaining process; and be it further
- Resolved that the 36th District Democrats will provide copies of this resolution to New Seasons Market management, Endeavour Capital, our elected officials, and Centercal, the developer of the Ballard New Seasons site; and be it further
- Resolved that the 36th District Democrats will publish this resolution on its website and in other online and print publications, as appropriate.
